USING A BOB PUNCH TO MAKE A CLIP





There are a lot of great pre-clipped options in the Kerckhaert program but developing the skills to clip, when and where you want a clip, is important. Mike Wildenstein, CJF FWCF (hons) used a Bloom Forge bob punch to put this toe clip on an unclipped Kerckhaert Standard shoe. This can be done in one heat but Mike used two so we could get these images along the way.



Bloom Wood Handled Bob Punch used to start source material for clip.



You can see the clip material begin to protrude.



View of source hole and clip material.



Place shoe over edge of anvil to set base of clip.



With cross tong grip, the clip is drawn on face of anvil.



Finished clip from ground surface.
